

Exclusions & Guidelines

SIGNS AND SYMPTOMS (Before Medical Diagnosis)	WHAT TO DO	WHAT NEEDS TO BE DONE (When diagnosed, refer to appropriate exposure notice)
1. Unable to take part comfortably in regular activities	Exclude after consultation with director.	Able to take part in activities.
2. Level of care or attention needed jeopardizes health/safety of others.	Exclude after consultation with director.	Able to be comfortable within ratio.
3. Head Lice	Exclude	Hair free of nits to return.
4. Runny Eyes: Watery red eyes	Observe	No action needed
Yellow/green discharge once	Observe	Clean eyes(outside corner in toward nose)and observe for more.
Yellow/green discharge reappears	Exclude	May return when on meds for 24 hours.
5. Ear Ache: Pain	Observe	Watch for fever or increase in pain
Ear drainage (no tubes)	Exclude	Doctor's diagnosis and medicine to return.
6. Nose/Mouth Discharge - clear, white, yellow	Observe	Watch for fever or foul oder
Discharge - green	Observe	Watch for other syptoms
Green discharge with other symptoms	Exclude	May return when symptoms are gone.
Sores - weepy/scaly	Exclude	Doctor's diagnosis and medicine to return.
7. Sore Throat: First complaint	Observe	Watch for other symptoms.
With fever	Exclude	Doctor's diagnosis and medicine to return.
8. Stiff Neck	Observe	Watch for other symptoms.
With temperature and/or headache	Exclude	Doctor's diagnosis to return.

<p>10. Fever (Temp taken axillary, underarm, only) Temperature of 100 Ax.</p>	<p>Exclude</p>	<p>Temp. Normal 24hrs without fever-reducing medications.</p>
<p>11. Respiratory: Uncontrolled coughing or sneezing</p> <p>Difficulty breathing</p> <p>Wheezing</p> <p>Previously diagnosed asthma wheezing</p>	<p>Exclude</p> <p>Exclude</p> <p>Exclude</p> <p>Observe</p>	<p>Return when controlled.</p> <p>Doctor's diagnoses to return.</p> <p>Doctor's diagnosis and breathing easily to return.</p> <p>Begin prescribed treatment and/or call parent.</p>
<p>12. Abdominal Pain: First complaint</p> <p>Continues for 2 hours or increases in severity</p>	<p>Observe</p> <p>Exclude</p>	<p>Watch for other symptoms.</p> <p>Symptoms must be gone to return.</p>
<p>13. Vomiting: One small amount w/o fever</p> <p>Two or more episodes in 24 hours</p>	<p>Observe</p> <p>Exclude</p>	<p>Watch for other symptoms.</p> <p>Return 12 hours after last vomiting.</p>
<p>14. Loose or watery BM Cannot be contained in diaper and/or Two or more episodes in 24 hours</p>	<p>Exclude</p> <p>Exclude</p>	<p>May return when symptoms are gone</p> <p>May return when symptoms are gone</p>
<p>15. Antibiotic Therapy</p>	<p>Exclude</p>	<p>May return after taking medicine for 24 hours.</p>
